Emergency Injury Plan

Location of the First Aid Kit in each classroom is marked with a red cross.

All information for each child in each classroom is in the child's confidential Folder, including parental permission for emergencies.

Emergency information for each child is also located in the school office on the secretary's desk.

Injured children will be taken to:

Procedures for obtaining emergency medical attention and transportation:

1. Emergency situation will be brought to the attention of the principal or pastor. In the absence of the principal or pastor, the teacher in charge will be notified.
2. The principal, pastor or teacher in charge will ascertain the need for immediate emergency care.
3. 911 will be called.
4. The parents will be called.
5. If the parent cannot be reached, the next Peron on the emergency form will be called.
6. After treatment by the responding emergency personnel, and depending on the advice of the responding emergency personnel, the child would be transported to a hospital. The principal or other staff member will accompany the child to the hospital.
7. Further effort will be made to contact parents.
